

**MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING
BETWEEN**

ZTEICT TECHNOLOGY CO, LTD

AND

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY of LEBANON

This MOU is entered by and between:-

(1) **ZTEICT Technology Co, Ltd**, herein after "ZTEICT", a university incorporated under the university laws of People's Republic of China, whose Principal Place of Business is L25,.R&D Building, ZTE Plaza, Hi-tech Industrial Park, Nanshan District, Shenzhen, China;

AND

"**Islamic University of Lebanon**", a university incorporated under the university laws of the Republic of Lebanon; herein after 'IUL', whose Principal Place of Business is Khalde highway, Beirut P.O. Box:30014.

RECITALS:

WHEREAS, IUL has expressed its interest in partnering with ZTEICT in projects related to the technologies, products, services and total solutions in all links of the GNSS and its relevant fields in the scope of cooperation.

NOW, THEREFORE, the Parties agree to jointly work together in the construction of the technologies, products, services and total solutions in all links of the GNSS in the scope of cooperation (hereinafter referred to as the "**Projects**").

Article I

Purpose

1. The purpose of this MOU is to provide a framework of cooperation and facilitate collaboration among the Parties, on a non-exclusive basis in the Projects.

Article II

Areas of Cooperation

- 2.1 The Parties agree to cooperate in the following areas of activity:
 - a. ZTEICT and IUL establish a GNSS (including the Beidou satellite navigation system and GRANAS and other satellite navigation system) joint laboratory in the spirit of honesty and mutual trust.
 - b. Establishing business contacts with interested and potential Chinese and other international companies who are committed to contribute to sustainable development in the scope of cooperation.
- 2.2 The Parties agree that this present cooperation is built on mutual trust among the Parties and that none of the Parties shall do any acts that undermine the interests of the other Party at all times. Honest and frank disclosures of information of the Projects are required throughout the term of cooperation which is formed of and in relation to this MOU among the Parties.

Article III

Implementation of the MOU

- 3.1 In order to meet the requirements of the technology, equipment function and performance reference which fit the need of the two cooperation countries. The promotion of the application is prospective.
- 3.2 In order to select a specific application for special usage, and to develop a set of prototype equipment, to construct at least more than one demo application system in the "The Belt and Road" countries
- 3.3 Cooperation on patents, high-level research papers and other scientific and technological cooperation.
- 3.4 The costs of public relations activities relating to this MOU, that are not otherwise addressed by a specific cost-sharing agreement concluded hereunder, will be the responsibility of each party independently.

- 3.5 Each Party shall be responsible for its own acts and omissions in connection with this MOU and its implementation.

Article IV

Duration, Termination, Modification

- 4.1 The proposed cooperation under this MOU is exclusive and shall have duration of an initial period of one year. The Parties may agree to extend the term of this MOU for a subsequent period up to three years, unless otherwise mutually agreed in writing.
- 4.2 This MOU shall be amended by mutual agreement in writing and duly executed by the Parties.

Article V

Notices and Addresses

- 5 All notices or other communications required or permitted to be given pursuant to or in reference to this MOU shall be in writing and shall be valid and sufficient if delivered or dispatched by registered mail, courier, personal delivery or fax (email NOT accepted) as the case may be, to the Party at the address set forth below in this MOU or as from time to time updated by each Party.

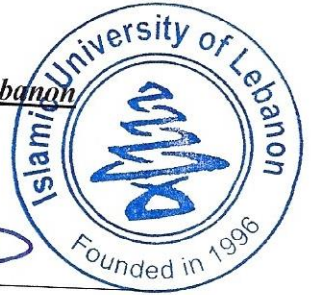
